The Leonor R. Fuller Gallery of Olympia's South Puget Sound Community College is a spacious, well-staffed gallery has been the pride of the state capitol's cultural life since it opened in 2006. Its director, Sean Barnes, is a hardworking, impassioned, kindhearted (but not TOO kindhearted) jewel, very like his predecessor, Nathan Barnes (no relation). Olympia is exceedingly lucky to have this remarkable space and inspired staffing.

Jurying needs to accomplish two purposes. Initially, work that offends the juror's sensibilities, right or wrong, steps aside. The collection that remains has to be looked at for minimal coherence; if a piece refuses to find a place within the community of disparate other works, that work too might need to go. There are works in this show that I didn't care about at all but weren't offensive and I was pretty sure some people would really love them. There were some that I found so hilarious that they just had to be seen by all of us. And there are some works that I myself simply love.

The collection you see here contains many varieties of liveliness. I see work done by long-term friends, consistent with their previous work but sporting new notions; I see work by artists I'd never heard of that knocked my socks off. I saw sharp new visions by old friends and a couple of classic pieces by other old friends. I saw work that were technically impeccable. I saw work that relies on its long background of previous success. I saw work that strains against its eccentricity.

We are a good community. We can teach each other. Thanks to our friends Leo Fuller and the South Puget Sound Community College for giving us this beautiful gallery, where all of our eyes can be startled open, and our minds given the support of new ideas fully resolved.

The Southwest Washington Juried Exhibition celebrates regional artists and awards artistic excellence. Invitation to submit was extended to artists working in all media and residing in Clark, Cowlitz, Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, Skamania, Thurston, and Wahkiakum counties. The response to the exhibition call was astounding with a total of 152 pieces submitted by 58 artists from around the region. Susan Christian, this year's guest juror, chose 39 works from 32 artists. The exhibition is now permanently archived in the SPSCC Leonor R. Fuller Gallery website.










