Sekiguchi's works are in private and public collections including Seattle Portable Works, and internationally in Laos, Morocco, and exhibited in Sweden. She recently created installations for the San Juan Island Museum of Art, the Wing Luke Asian Museum, and is currently working on a public art piece in Seattle. She is represented by ArtXchange Gallery in Seattle.

























