Submission Guidelines

- ❖ Submit 1 to 3 original artworks with a \$5 Entry Fee.
- ❖ Submissions will not be returned.
- ❖ Artwork must measure 4 by 6 inches and be on a stiff material, such as matboard, cardstock, foam core, thin wood panel or canvas board. *No glitter, no exceptions.
- ❖ Wall mounted flat work must be able to sit on a ¾” wide ledger board.
- ❖ 3-Dimensional artwork must not exceed 6 inches in any direction, must have a stable base, and be free standing.
- ❖ Artwork must not be framed or matted.
- ❖ Name of artist should appear on the back of each piece.
- ❖ Title and description are optional. Place on back of work.
- ❖ Artwork, artist contact information, and \$5 Entry Fee (cash or check payable to “SPSCC Foundation”) are due upon submission and may be mailed or hand delivered to:
