



2021 Southwest Washington Regional Juried Exhibition

The Southwest Washington Juried Exhibition is organized by The Leonor R. Fuller Gallery at the Kenneth J Minnaert Center for the Arts on the campus of South Puget Sound Community College. Artists working in all media and residing in Clark, Cowlitz, Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, Skamania, Thurston, or Wahkiakum counties are invited to submit an entry for consideration.

PRIZES

- > Merit Awards - \$100/each.
- > Purchase Awards.
- > Award winning artists invited back for the Juror's Invitational Exhibition in 2021.
- > Viewer's Choice - Winning artwork will be used for publicity the following season.

SUBMISSION RULES:

- > Artists must live in Clark, Cowlitz, Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, Skamania, Thurston, or Wahkiakum counties.
- > Artists must be 18 years of age or older to submit.
- > Entry fee is \$25 per artist.
- > Artists have the option of selling their artwork. The Gallery retains a 25% commission on all sales.

Include the following in one PDF document:

- > Completed entry form below.
- > Images of up to 3 artworks with no more than 3 additional detail images if desired.
- > **Artwork must have been created within the last 3 years**, must not exceed 72" in the longest dimension, and must weigh less than 150lbs.

IMPORTANT DATES

- May 7: Entries due.
- May 25: Notification of accepted artwork.
- June 21 - 23: Delivery of accepted artwork to The Leo Fuller Gallery between 12 – 6 p.m.
- July 12: Exhibition opens.
- July 15: Opening reception, awards presentation, and artist talks.
- August 22: Exhibition closes.
- August 23 - August 25: Pick up of artwork between 12 – 6 p.m.

Guest Juror: Aisha Harrison

Aisha discovered clay in a community studio, while working toward a degree in Spanish at Grinnell College in Iowa. After graduating, she spent the next two years teaching third and fourth grades in Atlanta, Georgia, and exploring clay at Callenwolde Fine Arts Center in Georgia, and Penland School of Crafts in North Carolina. Aisha decided to go back to school and received a BFA from Washington State University, and an MFA from University of Nebraska- Lincoln. Her work is shown nationally with recent work at Bainbridge Museum of Art and in the Store Front Windows Project in downtown Olympia (as a collaborator in the Black Well Red Thread Collective). She has done residencies at Watershed Center for the Ceramic Arts, Women's Studio Workshop, and Baltimore Clayworks. She has taught workshops/courses/programs at Bainbridge Island Museum of Art, Penland School of Crafts, The Evergreen State College, Bykota Senior Center, Baltimore Clayworks, University of Nebraska- Lincoln, and the Lux Center for the Arts.
