## SUBMISSION RULES

- > Submit a completed entry form with images of up to 3 artworks. Images must be in JPEG format and not exceed 800 pixels at the widest dimension. (Entry materials will not be returned).
- > Artwork must have been created within the last 3 years, must not exceed 72" in the longest dimension, and must weigh less than 150lbs.
- > Artists must live in Clark, Cowlitz, Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, Skamania, Thurston, or Wahkiakum counties.
- > Artists must be 18 years of age or older to submit.
- > Entry fee is \$25 per artist.
- > Artists have the option of selling their artwork. The Gallery retains a 25% commission on all sales.

## IMPORTANT DATES

- May 15:** Entries due
- June 1:** Notification of accepted artwork
- June 22, 23:** Delivery of accepted artwork to The Gallery between noon – 6 PM
- July 5:** Exhibition opens
- July 7:** Opening reception and awards presentation
- August 25:** Exhibition closes
- August 29, 30:** Pick up of artwork between noon – 6 PM

## JUROR

### **Esther Luttikhuizen:**

Visual arts professional Esther Luttikhuizen co-founded Esther Claypool Gallery, Seattle in 1998. The gallery represented primarily Northwest mid-career artists, earning a strong reputation for its progressive exhibitions. From 2004 to 2007, Luttikhuizen managed Kittredge Gallery at University of Puget Sound, Tacoma. From 2005 through 2015 she worked in public art, first as a project manager for ArtsWA, Olympia (Washington State Arts Commission), and then as collection curator at 4Culture (Cultural Authority of King County). From 2008 through 2015, Luttikhuizen managed Gallery4Culture, exhibiting King County artists. Over the past three decades, she has juried and curated numerous independent exhibitions. Luttikhuizen holds an MFA in studio art from the University of Washington, Seattle. She currently resides in Skagit County, Washington.
