Entry Deadline: Friday, December 1, 2017

Submission guidelines

- > Artists may submit up to 3 original artworks. Submissions will not be returned.
- > Artwork must measure four by six inches and be on a stiff material, such as matte board, cardstock, foam core, thin wood panel or canvas board.
- > 3- dimensional artwork must not exceed six inches in any direction and must have a stable base.
- > Artwork must not be framed or matted.
- > Name of artist should appear on the back of each piece.

- > Silent auction ends during the closing reception on **Friday, February 2, 2018** (6 – 8 p.m.)
