

**Elma HS SPSCC Course Equivalencies 2018-19 (Draft)**

Note: Students should check with their high school counselor for the specific credits they need to complete. Virtually all Elma High School Students, if beginning as a junior at SPSCC, need to satisfy credits in English, US History, Contemporary World Problems (Civics AND Economics), Math, and Science (for the classes of 2021+). Occupational Education, Fine Art, and Health and Fitness. The number of credits required for each subject area will vary for each student. High school credit is granted at a rate of 5 college credits to 1 high school credit. UPDATED 03/2018.
